

Handprint Sun Catchers




To make a handprint sun catcher follow these steps.

- 1. Place a piece of contact paper sticky side up on table.
- 2. Press tissue paper on contact paper.
- 3. Place another sheet of contact paper over the tissue paper, sticky side down.
- 4. Fold paper in half and trace child's hand on fold.
- 5. Cut paper and stick to window.

BRING THE STORY TO LIFE!

Become A Bucket Filler

Each of us has an invisible bucket. When our bucket is full, we feel great. When it's empty, we feel awful. Yet most children (and many adults) don't realize the importance of having a full bucket throughout the day.
