Reading this book provides the powerful opportunity to share how you and your family may sympathize or empathize with the characters. If you can understand a hardship or relate to one, reflecting together as a family can be a great way to converse about the story.

Tip #3 – This is a fantastic book for discussion. New Orleans, like many cities, has a rich culture and way of life. Can you and your child recall some of the characters' favorite things? What are some of your ways of celebrating community and culture?
