



White, Tan and Brown Construction Paper

Glue

Cut a moose head shape like the attached outline using brown paper and then cut our antlers from tan paper. Use white paper to cut eyes for your moose. Glue your eyes and antlers onto your moose. Cut the yarn into ten pieces that are 1 foot long. Glue the yarn on your moose as a Moosetache.


